



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
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### #7 – Test Security Starts At The Top

#6 Show off your hardwork.

- Create a District Monitoring Team
- Use all of Central Office Personnel not giving a test. (Supt, Asst. Supt, Curriculum, Athletic Director, Special Ed Director, etc)
- Do abbreviated training with them and have them sign a security oath.
- It benefits you two ways: shows all of the organization that it takes to pull off a testing session, shows test monitors that you meant it when you said test integrity is an expectation.
- Should an accusation of impropriety arise you have documentation that you had people monitoring the monitors and nothing was reported.

#### **Breaks**

Students are allowed to take breaks during the administration of STAAR assessments. Some breaks are included in the time limit; others require the test administrator to stop the testing time for the group or for an individual student. Breaks are classified in two ways:

- Breaks included in the time limit (not allowed to stop the time clock)
  - water breaks
  - · bathroom breaks
  - snack breaks
  - · short physical or mental breaks
- Breaks NOT included in the time limit (required to stop and restart the time clock)
  - lunch
  - · emergency situations that significantly interrupt testing
  - · consolidation and movement of students to another testing area
  - medical breaks

Test administrators should document stop and restart times when breaks are given.
